For those considering the ministry, you are welcome to join the students for their first lecture at 8.30am. If you prefer a later start, then please see the planned timing of the day below:

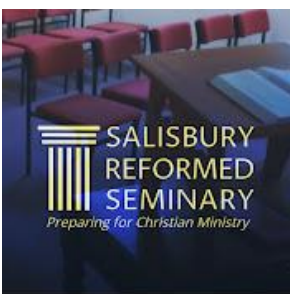
